




Find more recent contributions to history, from the Holocaust Museuem to the National Gallery of Art.




See history in the making! We'll see cases argued at the Supreme Court, the halls of Congress, and memorials to soldiers still giving their lives in service to our nation.

We'll wrap up with a trip to Kings Dominion, one of the premier amusement parks on the East Coast.

Kings Dominion Facts:

- Kings Dominion is 400 acres in size. (Compare this with Valleyfair at 125 acres.)
- Kings Dominion has 13 roller coasters and over 60 attractions.
- The Intimidator 305 coaster is tied for 8th tallest in the world and is 100 feet taller than Valleyfair's Wild Thing.
